Types of Data collected

Legal basis of processing

- processing is related to a task that is carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the Owner;

• processing is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the Owner or by a third party. In any case, the Owner will gladly help to clarify the specific legal basis that applies to the processing, and in particular whether the provision of Personal Data is a statutory or contractual requirement, or a requirement necessary to enter into a contract.

Place

The Data is processed at the Owner's operating offices and in any other places where the parties involved in the processing are located.

Depending on the User's location, data transfers may involve transferring the User's Data to a country other than their own. These countries may not have data protection laws as comprehensive or protective as those of your country or residence. Whenever we transfer your personal data out of the EEA, we ensure a similar degree of protection is afforded to it by implementing the safeguards contained in this privacy policy. If applicable, for personal data we receive from the EEA, we provide adequate safeguards for your personal information by requiring the receiving organization to agree to standard data protection clauses adopted by the European Data Protection Commission.

Retention time

Personal Data shall be processed and stored for as long as required by the purpose they have been collected for. Therefore:

The rights of Users

Under certain circumstances users may exercise certain rights regarding their Data processed by the Owner. Users entitled to broader protection standards may exercise any of the rights described below. In all other cases, Users may inquire with the Owner to find out which rights apply to them.

- Verify and seek rectification. Users have the right to verify the accuracy of their Data and ask for it to be updated or corrected, though we may need to verify the accuracy of the new Data provided to us.
- **Restrict the processing of their Data.** Users may have the right, under the following circumstances, to restrict the processing of their Data:
- If you want us to verify the accuracy of the Data.
- Where the Data has been unlawfully processed but you do not want us to delete it.
- If we no longer need the Data but you need us to keep it to establish, exercise, or defend a legal claim.
- If you have objected to our processing the data, but we need to consider whether legitimate grounds override your objection.
 - 1. In this case, the Owner will not process their Data for any purpose other than storing it.
- Have their Personal Data deleted or otherwise removed. Users may have the right, under certain circumstances, to obtain the erasure of their Data from the Owner. We may not always be able to comply with your deletion request for legal reasons. In such cases, we will notify you of the reasons for denying the request at the time of your request.
- Receive their Data and have it transferred to another controller. Users have the right to receive the Data that such Users have provided to us in a structured, commonly used and machine readable format and, if technically feasible, to have it transmitted to another controller without any hindrance. This provision is applicable provided that (1) the Data is processed by automated means and (2) the processing is based on the User's consent or for the performance of a contract which the User is part of or on pre-contractual obligations thereof.
- Lodge a complaint. Users have the right to bring a claim before their competent supervisory authority. We would appreciate the opportunity to handle your concerns before you contact the supervisory authority, so please contact us prior to bringing a claim before the supervisory authority.

Details about the right to object to processing

Where Personal Data is processed for a public interest, in the exercise of an official authority vested in the Owner or for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the Owner, Users may object to such processing by providing a ground related to their particular situation to justify the objection.

Users must know that, however, should their Personal Data be processed for direct marketing purposes, they can object to that processing at any time without providing any justification.
